

General donations

The CPD will accept general (untied) donations from any organisation or individual, as long as their known public aims and behaviour does not conflict with CPD values.

All donors of amounts greater than \$100 in a year, both individuals and organisations, both large and small, will be thanked publicly on the donors page of our website, with the exception of any individual donors who wish to remain anonymous for privacy reasons.

Tied donations

The CPD will accept donations for specific projects, e.g. policy papers, events, fellowships or ongoing research programs. Any events/publications funded from tied donations will publicly acknowledge the donor, e.g. on the intro page.

Donors may be invited to contribute feedback on draft papers, but final editorial control will remain with the author and editor. Donors do not have a publication veto.

Sponsorship

The CPD will accept sponsorship for events, fellowships, and research programs, but not publications. Naming rights will not be offered as part of sponsorship deals. Sponsors will not have any control over the content of speeches or papers presented at events, although major sponsors may be asked to speak themselves.

Commissioned work

CPD will occasionally accept commissioned work, either in the form of research, advice or appearances. Any intellectual property generated through such work will be retained by the CPD. CPD retains the right to republish commissioned work on our own website. Feedback will be sought from the commissioning agent, however final editorial control over the published results of research will remain with the researcher/author and the Research Committee.

Advertising

The CPD will accept advertising in its publications, as long as it does not conflict with CPD values. It will also accept advertising on the back or inside back cover of its policy papers, both web and print versions.

Editorial independence

No financial support of any kind confers on the supporter the power to approve, change or veto any CPD content. However, CPD recognises that many of our supporters have expertise on the areas in which we work and we will seek the advice of our supporters along with other advisors where appropriate.

In order to ensure our ongoing independence, CPD will continue to seek a diverse funding base, with funding from a mix of sources including small and large individual donations, foundation or philanthropic funding, union and corporate donations and sponsorship and fundraising events.
